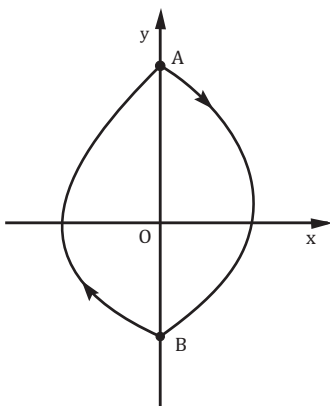


Figure 1. The caption of your figure. You could insert a *.eps or a *.pdf figure here.

name1 and name2, *Name of The Book*, Publisher, address, year.

2. Journal reference (*Capitalize the first letter of the first word of paper title only*):

name1, name2 and name3, *Name of the paper*, Name of The Journal, Year, Vol(No), firstpage–lastpage.

3. Article without volume and number:

name1, name2 and name3, *Name of the paper*, Name of The Journal, Year.
