The signed Transfer of Copyright empowers the Publisher on behalf of the Author(s) to protect the Work and its images against any unauthorized use, and to properly authorize dissemination of the Work. The editors will supply the necessary forms for this transfer.

Authors will receive one set of proofs for correction. No alterations or corrections beyond corrections on minor typographic errors will normally be accepted once the set of proofs is issued.
